Charger Energy bought Sirius effective March 6, 2012, and will be taking over the drilling and completion of the well.
2 Pre-spud Notification	Licensee shall submit a Commencement of Drilling Operations notification to the ERCB Drayton Valley Field Centre via e-mail (draytonvalley.fieldcentre@ercb.ca) at least 48 hours prior to spudding the well.	Section: Paragraph 1 P. 1	Drayton Valley Field Centre will confirm that notification is received.	Pending -
3 Surface Casing Inspection	Licensee shall provide 24 hours notification to the ERCB Drayton Valley Field Centre once surface casing is set following which an ERCB inspection will be conducted.	Section: Paragraph 1 P. 1	Once the email notification is received, the Field Centre will conduct its inspection before any further drilling can occur.	Pending -
4 Presour Meeting attendance	Licensee shall provide 24 hours notification to the ERCB Drayton Valley Field Centre in advance of a presour meeting so field staff can attend.	Section: Paragraph 1 P. 1	Once the email notification is received, field staff will attend the presour meeting.	Pending -
5 Pre Drill Out Inspection	Prior to drilling out intermediate casing and entering any formations containing hydrogen sulphide (H ₂ S), licensee shall provide the ERCB Drayton Valley Field Centre with 48 hours notification and the ERCB will then conduct a pre drill out inspection.	Section: Paragraph 1 P. 1	Once notified by email, field staff will conduct pre drill out inspections before the licensee drills through each of the Nordegg and Nisku formations.	Pending -

The conditions imposed in approvals/licence(s) are monitored by the Alberta Energy Resources Conservation Board (ERCB). The ERCB has developed a process whereby an action plan is developed internally to ensure that ERCB staff monitor conditions arising from decision reports for compliance. The conditions are managed in an action plan that is updated quarterly with statuses of conditions. The action plan defines the action required, timeframes for completion, and a summary of the evidence provided to confirm a condition was met.
